The North Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA), a multi-agency effort formed to comply with passage of the California Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014, has launched a website to provide information about meetings, notices, events and groundwater information resources, and to allow stakeholders to sign up and receive email updates on agency activities.

Core functions of the website:

- Provide the public, landowners and other interested parties with current information on the progress and decision-making structure of the North Kings GSA
- Serve as a key gateway for stakeholders to learn how to participate in the agency's development of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan as required by the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act

The North Kings GSA is one of seven Groundwater Sustainability Agencies established in the Kings Subbasin (5-022.08). Pursuant to state Water Code Section 10723.8, the agency's board of directors notified the California Department of Water Resources on Jan. 3, 2017, of its intent to serve as the exclusive GSA for its portion of the subbasin.

As required by state law, all seven GSAs in the Kings Subbasin have met the June 30, 2017 state deadline to file to serve as the GSAs for the subbasin with no overlaps or unmanaged areas within the subbasin. Subbasins that fail to meet this deadline are subject to intervention by the State Water Resources Control Board.

*About NKGSA: The North Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency is a Joint Powers Authority formed in December 2016. Composed of local public agencies and others engaged through binding agreements, the NKGSA is the governing body for of a portion of the Kings Subbasin (DWR Bulletin 118, 5-22.08) in compliance with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014. NKGSA members are Bakman Water Company, Biola Community Services District, City of Clovis, City of Fresno, City of Kerman, County of Fresno, Fresno Irrigation District, Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District, Garfield Water District, and International Water District.*
