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Project Location:

The proposed location for Basin "EN" is located at the northwest corner of Gettysburg and Garfield Avenues. The basin is proposed to be located on the north and west area of APN 512-021-18. Basin "EN" is in the County of Fresno and just outside the City of Fresno Sphere of Influence. Drainage Area "EN" is mostly within the City of Fresno Sphere and partially outside of the Sphere. The Drainage Area is an irregular shape within the boundaries of Barstow alignment, the Herndon Canal, Garfield Avenue, Gettysburg Avenue and Hayes Avenue.

Project Description:

This project is for the acquisition and construction of a stormwater management basin. The proposed project includes acquiring 16.80 acres of APN 512-021-18 to develop a stormwater management basin. The proposed Basin "EN" will serve an approximately 646 acre drainage area. The basin site will be developed by excavating 367,808 cubic yards of dirt and constructing a perimeter fence, a pump station and two outfall structures.

Finding:

It is hereby found, that the above-mentioned project will not have a significant effect on the environment.


Initial Study:
