The Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District (District) is seeking a collaborative, solutions-oriented self-starter with a passion for environmental issues to join our Environmental Team. This full time position is responsible for activities related to the District's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System stormwater quality management program. These activities include conducting stormwater inspections, responding to illicit connections and discharges, and assisting with public outreach and education. Other duties may include the coordination of environmental site assessments and hazardous substance surveys with local consulting firms, maintaining and installing storm drain markers and inventory, and wildlife surveys. The ideal candidate for this position will be familiar with stormwater quality best management practices, inspecting industrial and construction sites, hazardous waste clean-up and response activities, ability to interpret technical drawings or reports, and able to perform water quality monitoring.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform the job duties satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

Education: High school education or equivalent is required.

Experience: The position requires one year of related work experience in any of the related fields; including experience as a Facilities Technician, Construction Technician, and Design Technician.

Substitution: A Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental Science, or related field with specialization in environmental quality management may be substituted for the experience requirement.

Registrations, Licenses, Certificates: Must possess a valid California Driver's License and satisfactory driving record. A DMV record search may be required by the District prior to final appointment and will be performed annually. **Possession of Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP), and/or Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD), and/or Qualified Industrial Storm Water Practitioner (QISP) are highly desirable.**
